

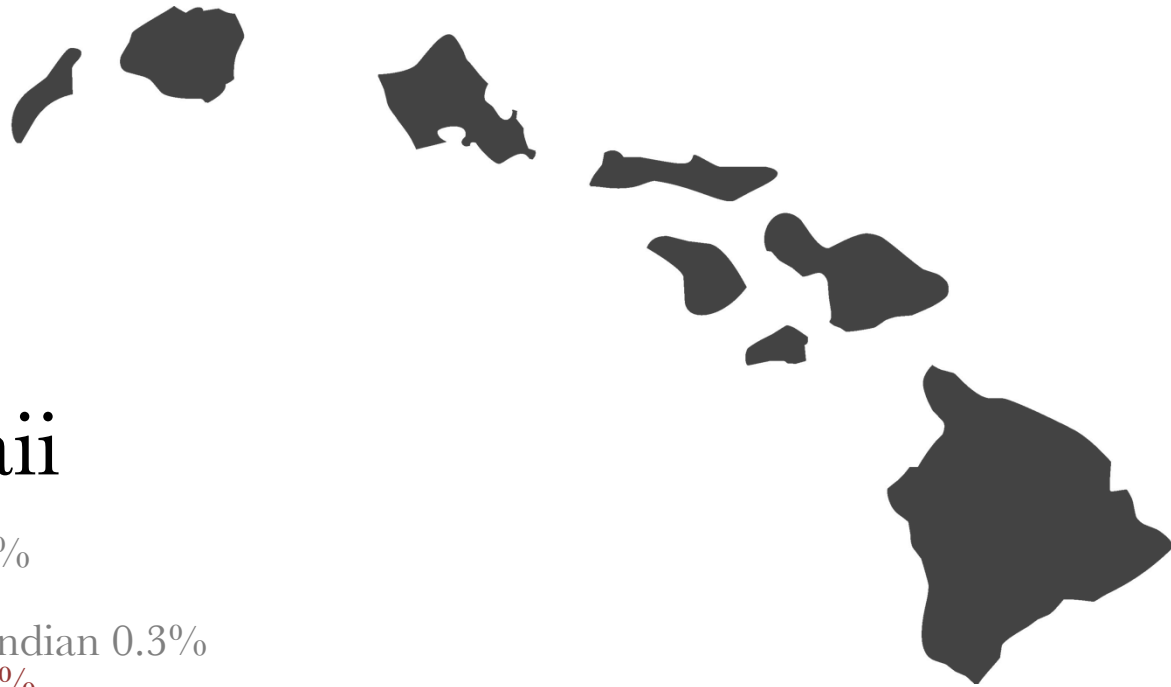

Two or more races 23.6%

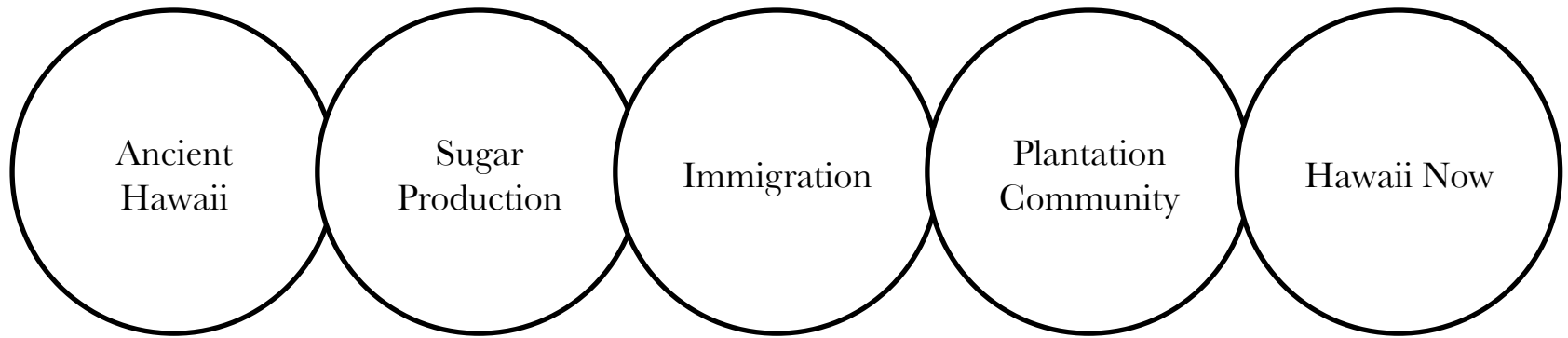

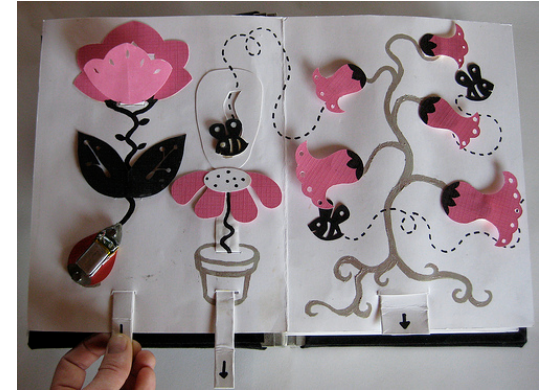
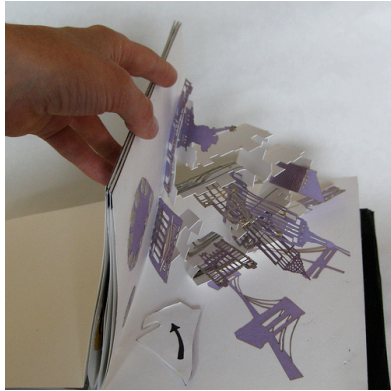
