

FOOD ESERT is a term that describes geographic areas where mainstream grocery stores are either totally absent or inaccessible to low-income shoppers.

Though these may be located in the vicinity, they remain unavailable to low-income residents because of high prices and inadequate public transit. While the phenomenon is typically associated with large, urban communities, it can also occur in rural neighborhoods.


